NOM buys Wimax sales system from Suntech

Polish operator NOM has purchased a sales provisioning system for Wimax services, in an agreement with the Polish branch of Suntech. The system will accelerate processes for installation, reconfiguration and activation of Wimax services. The system enables the company to cut the time for activation of the service to 30 minutes. The system will be launched in December.
